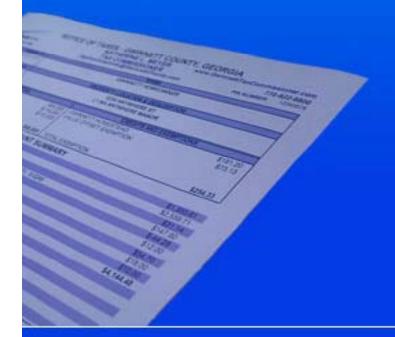

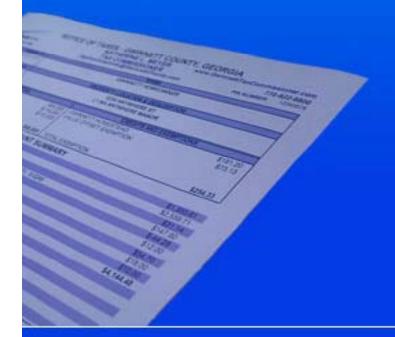

### Office Overview

- Elected Constitutional Officer
- \* Bills and collects property taxes, fees
- **❖** Bills and collects motor vehicle taxes, fees
- Tag agent for the state
- Services provided generate revenue and/or are mandated by law



### Office Overview

In 2009 -

- Directly served 866,002 customers
- Processed 1,601,332 transactions
- Collected and disbursed \$1,068,076,660



### Office Overview

## Property taxes represent 75% of the total FY 2010 General Fund revenues



### 2009 Statistics

#### **Department of Property Tax**

- Served 301,604 customers and processed 545,150 transactions
- Collected \$980,330,161

#### **Department of Motor Vehicles**

- Served 564,398 customers and processed 1,056,182 transactions
- Collected \$87,746,499



## 2010 Summary

- ❖ Total 2010 budget: \$9,399,644
- 128 employees
- ❖ Billed for a third installment of 2009 property taxes
  - 2009 taxes 97.37% collected as of 9/15/2010
- ❖ 306,000 property tax bills mailed July 22, 2010
- Began billing and collection of Solid Waste fees



## gwinnettcounty 2010 Core Budget Changes

- No changes in base budget amount
- Additional \$240,000 provided for 2009 third installment billing
- ❖ Additional \$88,000 for Link2Gov charges



## **2011 Service Enhancements**

#### Addition of Four Delinquent Collectors to Full-Time Staff

- In 2009, three Delinquent Collectors collected \$4,819,663 through their individual efforts
- Adding positions will increase delinquent collections by
  - Increasing the frequency of contact with delinquent taxpayers
  - Increasing efficiencies in the filing and sale of tax liens, and in the preparation of tax sales



## gwinnettcounty 2011 Service Enhancements

#### Addition of Four Delinquent Collectors to Full-Time Staff

The cost of four additional positions - \$196,613 per year, with an increase in delinquent collections of as much as \$4 million per year based on the current success rate

\*State of Georgia is adding 32 delinquent collectors which are expected to pay for themselves in four months



## gwinnettcounty 2011 Service Enhancements

#### **Manatron Tax System Programming**

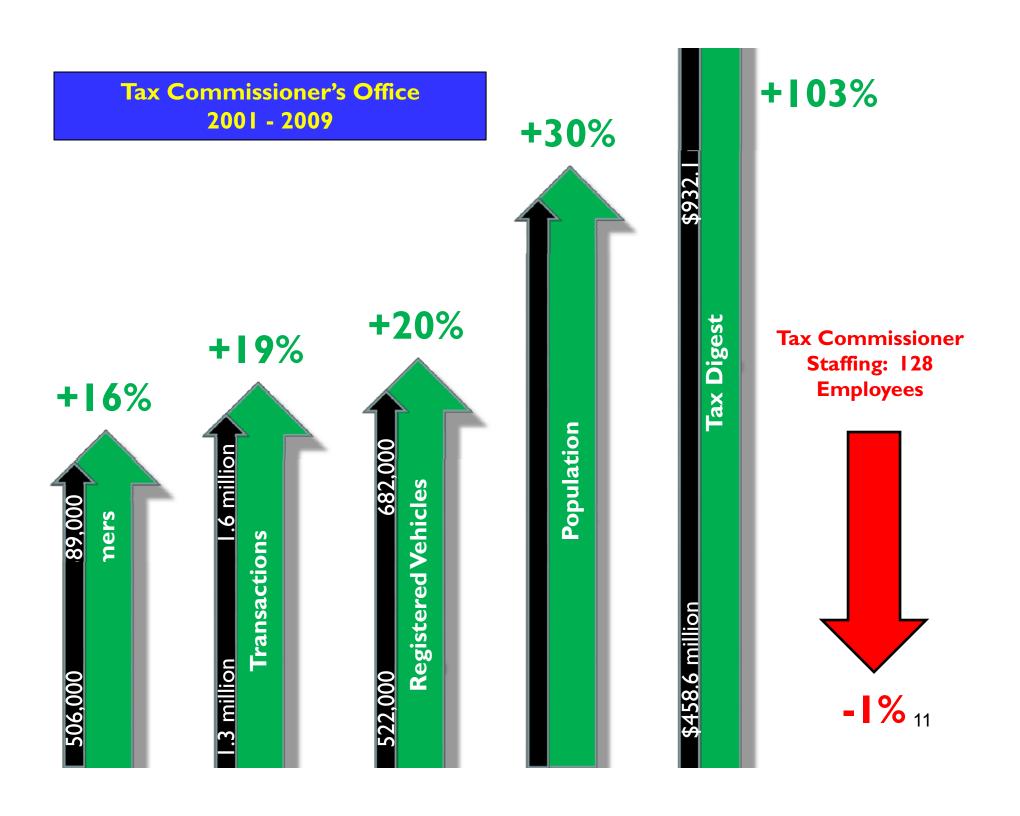
- ❖ A necessary upgrade to the Manatron property tax system will go live in January 2011
- The upgrade will provide increased flexibility in the billing of property taxes in future years
- Additional funding of \$10,000 is needed to program Gwinnett-specific requirements not included in the existing product



## gwinnettcounty 2011 Service Reductions

#### None recommended

- Services generate revenue -- reduction in services reduces collection efficiencies
- Some services cannot be cut due to mandates
