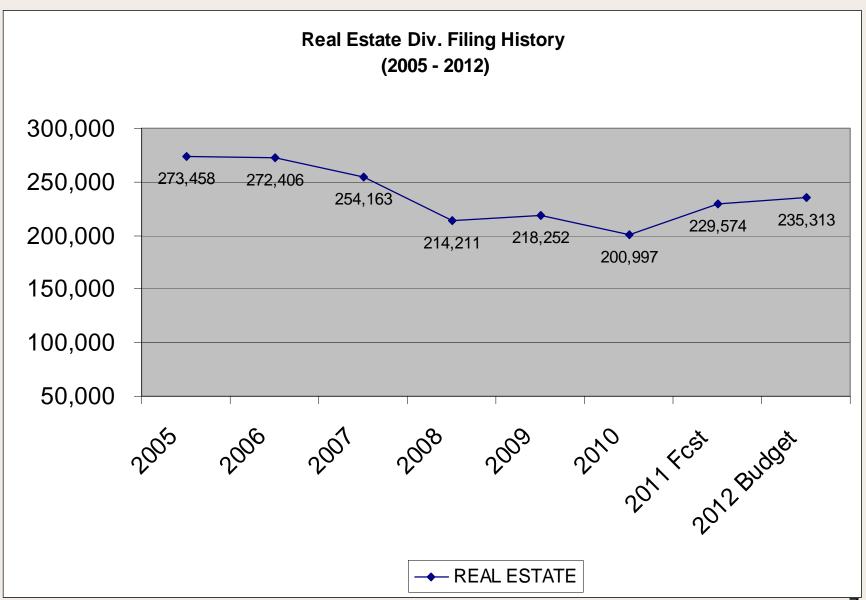

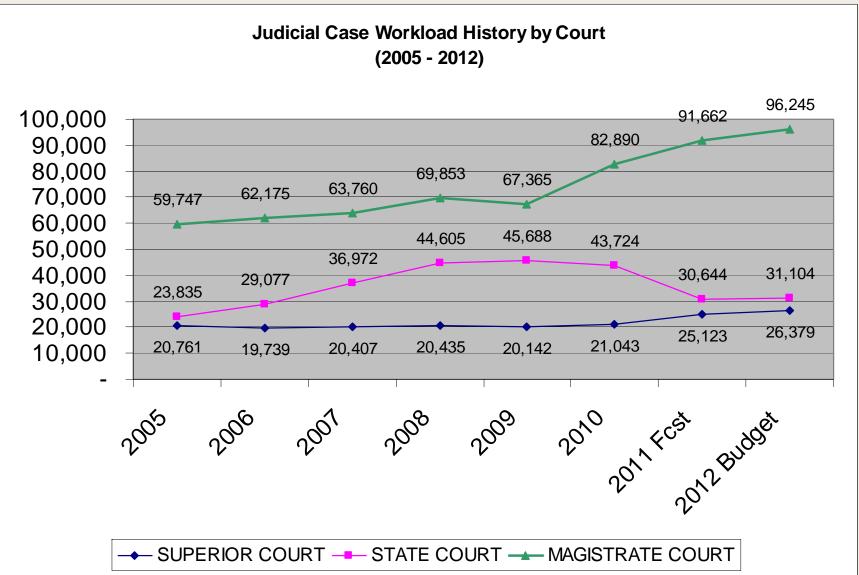

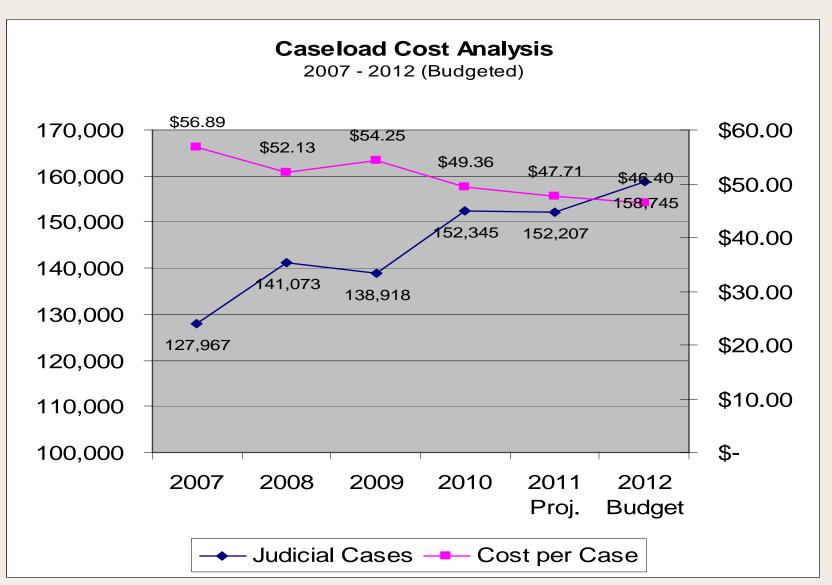


Average growth rate: 6.2%

# Decision Package: (12-CLK-COC) Clerk of Court:

- Business Officer Position:
  - Assist with 2010 audit recommendations
    - Segregation of duties
    - Agency fund ledger maintenance
    - Old Outstanding Check reconciliation
  - Assist with growing accounting requirements
    - System Conversion (Quicken Sage MAS 500)
    - System Integration (Sage Sustain Upgrade)
    - 13 Operating Accounts, 71K Transactions, \$75M+
       Fund Management
    - Centralized payment processing
  - Assist with Unclaimed Funds reconciliation
    - Cash Bonds (Est. County Revenue \$500K+)
  - Budget impact: \$69.3K

# Clerk of Court – 2012 Operating Budget



### Decision Package: (12-CLK-BOE)

#### Board of Equalization (BOE):

- Deputy Clerk Position:
  - Projected work load increase
    - Appeals: 31,201 (50% increase vs. 2011 Budget)
    - Hearings: 13,600 (estimated) vs. 4,400 in 2010
  - Current staff:
    - Two full time clerks, one part time
  - Departmental needs:
    - Three full time clerks
    - Status change: Part time position to full time
  - Budget impact: \$28.2K

# Clerk of Court – 2012 Operating Budget



#### **Summary:**

- Clerk of Court duties and responsibilities are mandated by the State
- 2011 financials projections reflect favorable revenue and expense capacities (\$874K)
- Current operating efficiencies reflected in the 2012 Budget
  - Cross utilization of personnel resources
  - Payment posting / processing system
  - Online confirmed delivery-certified mail
- Current Judicial Case Workload continues to rise
  - Case workload projected at 1,804 per clerk
- Records management storage near capacity
  - Six month capacity
  - Offsite storage considerations
  - Digital imaging

## Clerk of Court – 2012 Operating Budget (cont')



#### **Summary:**

- 2012 Operating Budget as proposed with Decision Packages shall allow Clerk of Court to maintain acceptable service levels without compromising the Mission Statement and Clerk of Court Goals:
  - To enter and record all orders, decrees, judgments and other proceedings of the Superior, State, and Magistrate Courts of Gwinnett County, as well as other duties required by law
  - To provide quality and timely service while maintaining budget expenses at the lowest possible level



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
