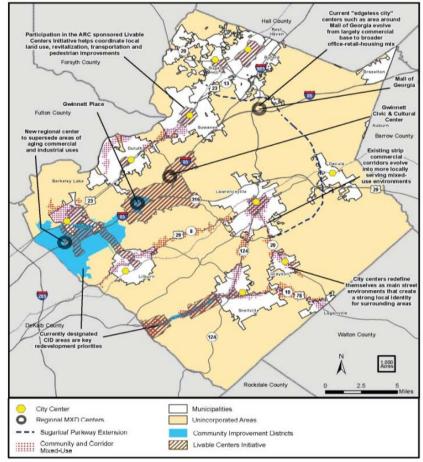


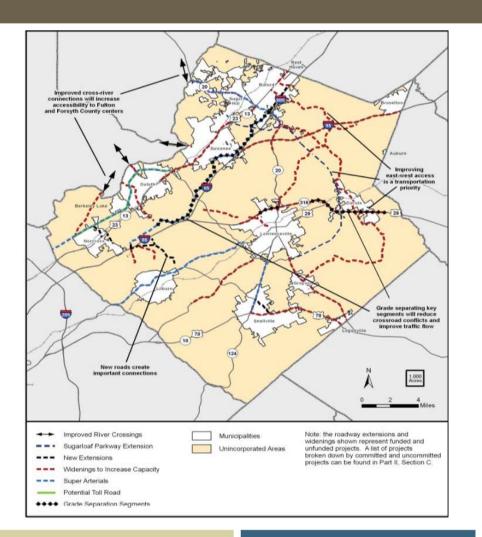
## <u>Maintain Economic</u> Development & Fiscal Health

- Allow "corner stores" within specified Med/High Density Areas



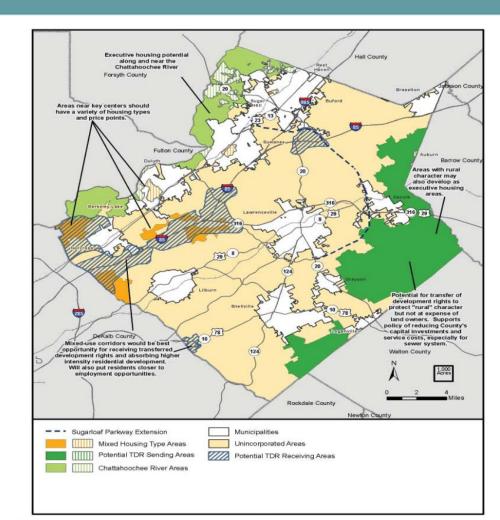


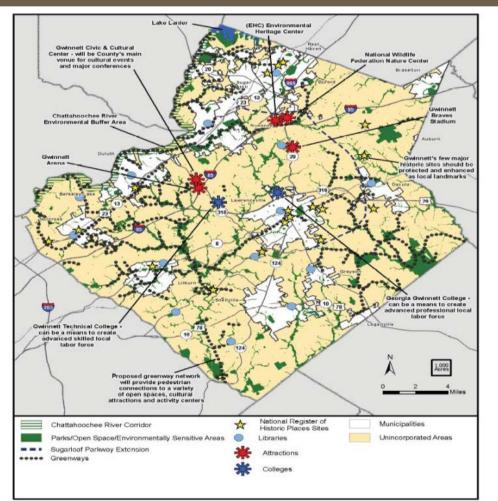

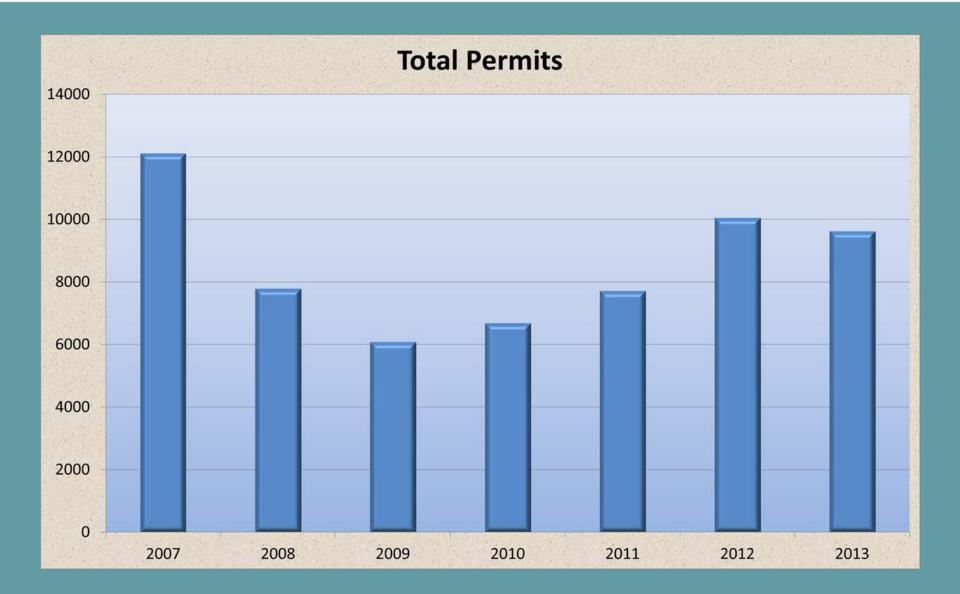




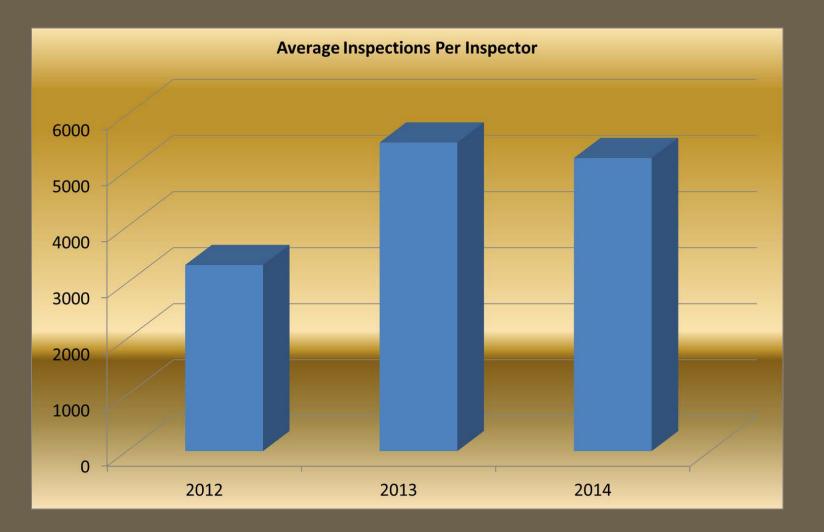
## **Single Family Building Permits**

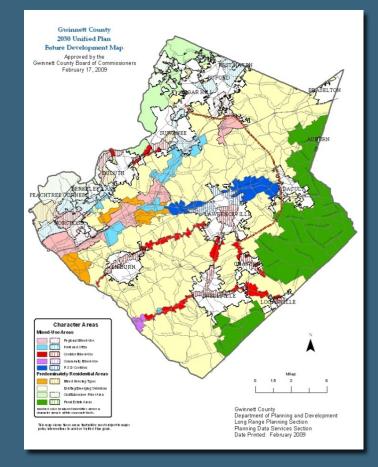
