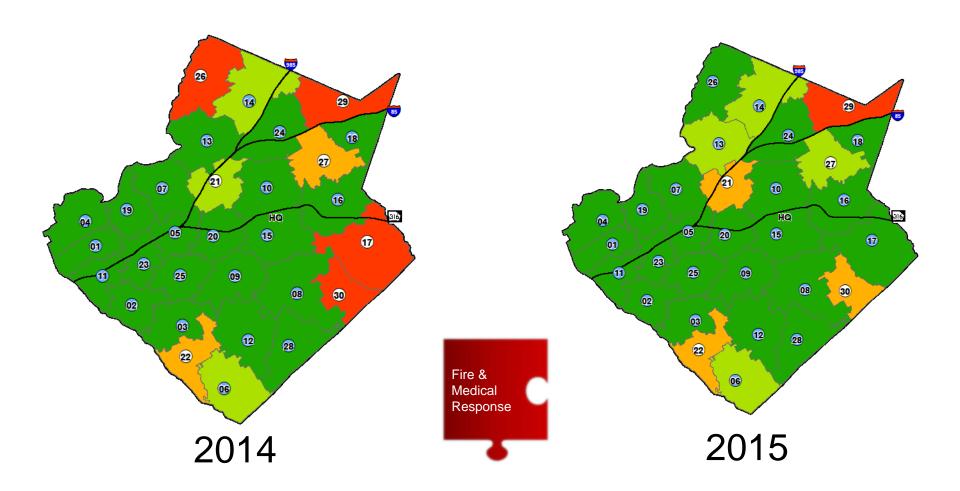






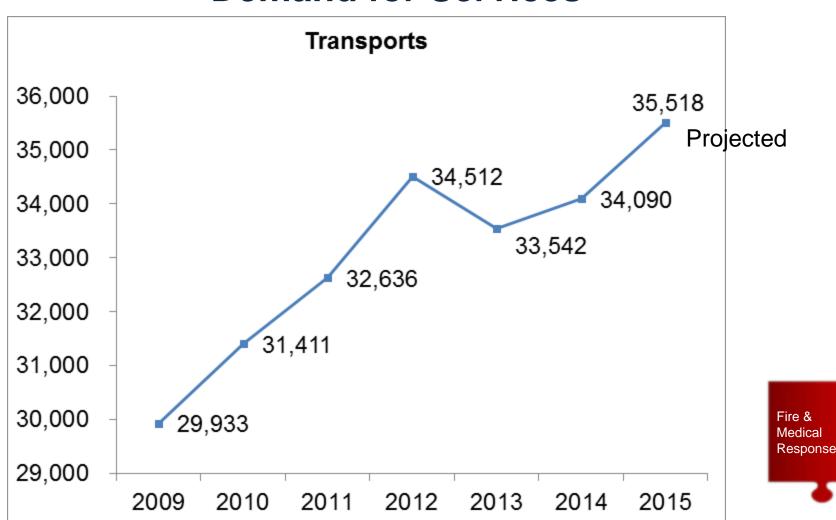


Two New Medic Units for Harbins and Sugar Hill





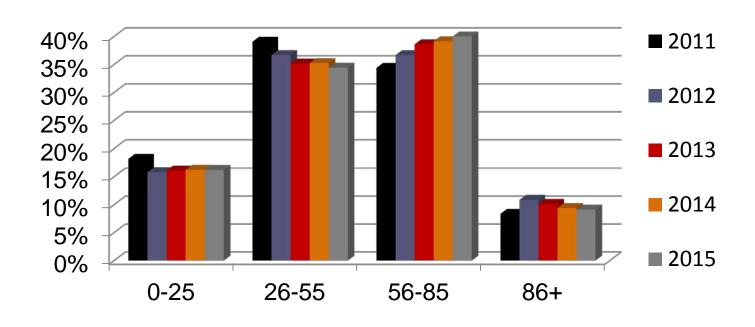

Transports by Age Group

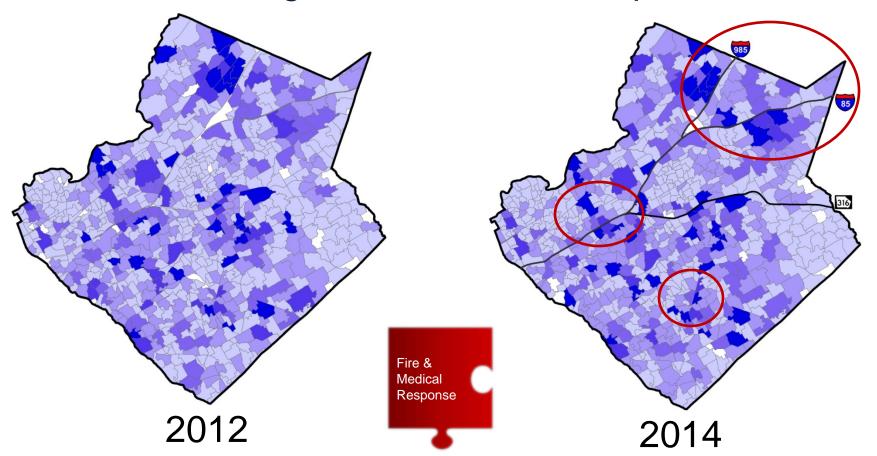






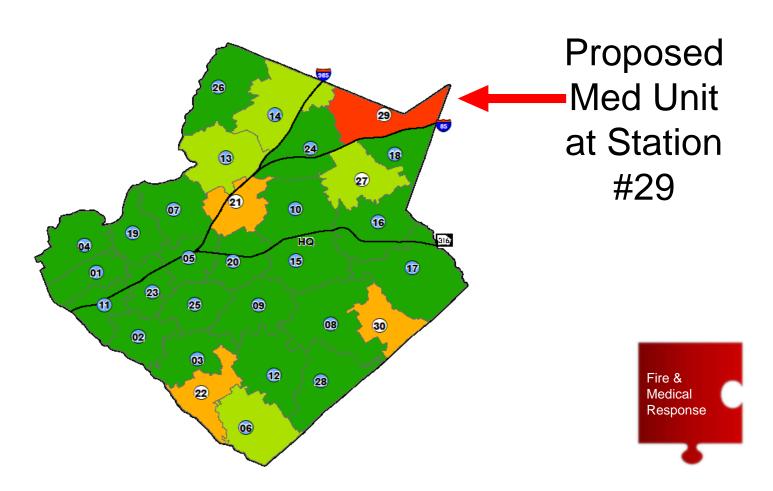
Demand for Services

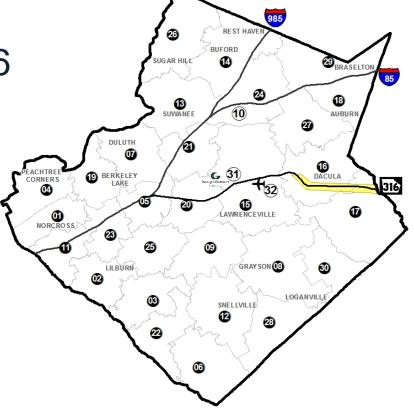

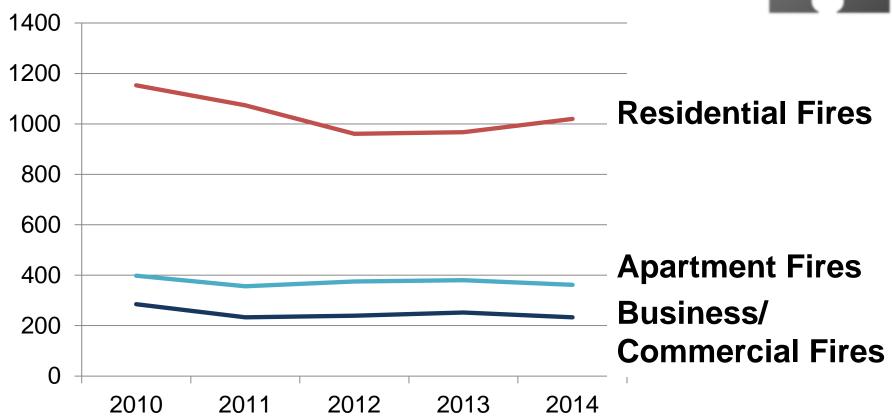

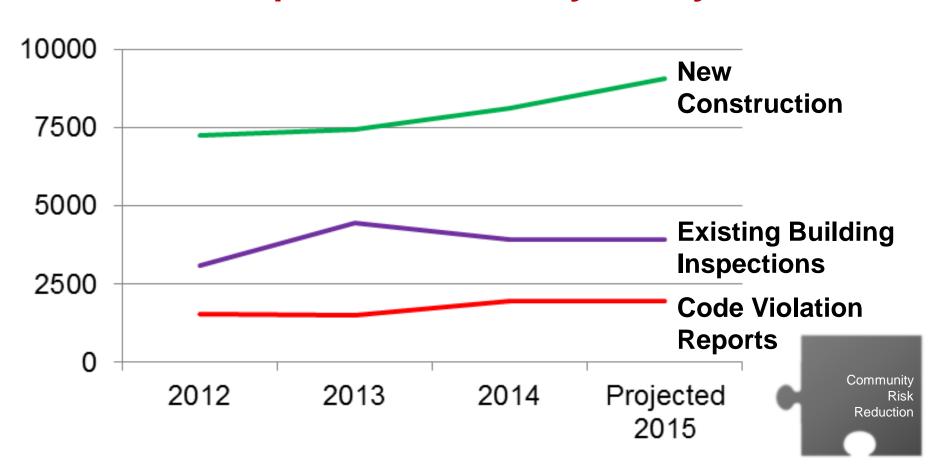
