| On-site/off-site water: A permit is required for installation of on-site and off-site water systems. A single permit may be purchased if plans for both on-site and off-site systems have been approved and are installed at the same time or a permit for each system can be purchased separately. On-site/off-site sewer: A permit is required for installation of on-site and off-site sewer systems. A single permit may be purchased if plans for both on-site and off-site sewer: A permit is required for installation of on-site and off-site sewer systems.
